What to Bring

Enrollment forms and health records

Prior to care, please fill out the forms on the back-up care portal:

backup.brighthorizons.com/account/login — they will need to be submitted along with your child's health and immunization records.

Meals and snacks

Morning and afternoon snack are included, and consist of a fruit, vegetable, protein or carbohydrate, and milk. Please bring your child's lunch, ready to eat, and stored in a bag with ice packs, as needed. *Please note that our center is nut-safe.* There is a fridge available for bottles in our infant classroom. All bottles must be prepared at home, and will be warmed at the center using a water bath method.

Items from home

- Spare clothing
- Diapers and wipes (as needed)
- Crib-sized sheet and blanket for rest times
- Favorite toy, book, etc. to ease the drop-off transition and/or for rest time
- Ready-to-eat lunch and bottles (as needed)



How to Find Us

Our center is located in the 388 Citi building (between N. Moore and Beach Street) on the first floor.

Public transportation:

Take the A, C, or E subway lines to Canal Street. Exit on Walker Street and walk west to Beach Street. You will pass Beach Street Park and 1st Precinct before arriving at Greenwich Street.

Or, take the 1 train to Franklin Street and walk west to Greenwich Street. Then, turn right toward N. Moore.
