- What in the World?:** Cornstarch Goop
- What do you need?:** 1c. cornstarch, 1c. water, tub or large pan, spatula, spoon, other kitchen gadgets.
- What you do:** Put cornstarch in pan. Slowly add water to cornstarch. Let your child stir. This makes a very interesting consistency, part liquid and part solid. Scoop and scratch with kitchen gadgets.
- Tips:** This can make a mess, so do this in the kitchen. You may want to put an apron or an old shirt on your child. When your child is through, keep cornstarch goop in a container for the next time. It will dry out but can be revitalized by just adding water.
- Value:** Science Rocks — Observation skills, properties of liquid vs. solid, changes in matter, sensory experience, vocabulary.
- Variations:** Add a little food coloring to the water. Make two batches of different colors and slowly mix together.
