- What in the World?:** Water Sprinkling Toys
- What do you need?:** An empty plastic container such as a frosting container or butter tub, tool to poke holes in bottom – nail, knife, ice pick
- What you do:** The adult pokes holes in the bottom of the container and makes it available for bath time or sink play. Make some toys with one hole and others with many holes.
- Tips:** The more variety of sizes and holes you have, the quicker your child will notice differences in speed of emptying or force of the water.
- Value:** Science Rocks — Gravity and volume.
- Variations:** Older children may want to construct a waterway that includes several containers emptying into others. Add some clear plastic tubing and see if they can fit it into the holes.
