



OUR COVID-19 POLICY

Please review and be familiar with our current COVID-19 policy.

This policy prohibits certain individuals and their households from entering the center following confirmed or suspected exposures and after travel to restricted areas.

EACH PERSON ARRIVING AT THE CENTER WILL UNDERGO A DAILY HEALTH SCREEN:

To accomplish the health screen there will be staff members in the front lobby.

Families are asked to allow 6 feet of distance between one another while waiting for their health screen.

- ▶ A staff member will take the temperature of each person present. Any person with a fever of 100.4 F or above will not be permitted to enter.
- ▶ Each person will be asked the following questions: Any person/household who answers “**YES**” to any question will not be permitted to enter.
 - A** Do you or any member of your household:
 - ▶ Have a fever of 100.4 F or above now or in the preceding 72 hours?
 - ▶ Have a cough?
 - ▶ Have a sore throat?
 - ▶ Have any muscle aches?
 - ▶ Have any difficulty breathing?
 - B** In the last 14 days, have you or anyone in your household:
 - ▶ Had a suspected or confirmed case of COVID-19?
 - ▶ Been tested, been advised to be tested or is awaiting test results for COVID-19 (regardless of the result)?
 - ▶ Self-isolated or been directed to quarantine due to Covid-19?
 - ▶ Traveled to a restricted area?

Once a family has completed their health screen, a designated staff member will escort the children to their classrooms.

AT PICK UP:

- ▶ Staff will be available in the lobby to check ID against authorized pick-up list
- ▶ Staff will then go and bring the child from their classroom
- ▶ When a child is being picked up because they or their parent are ill, the parent should not come into the center, a staff member must bring the child outside to the authorized pick up person.
