- Reviewed the leadership changes that will be taking place at the JCCC

- Mr. Jason and Ms. Jacqueline will overlap for 2 weeks to allow Ms. Jacqueline to get acclimated to our center and processes
- Ms. Rosalind's Regional Manager duties will change as of December 3, 2021
- Will continue to be the RM for JCCC but will take on several other client and community centers in her role as Regional Manager

Hiring Updates

- Our goal is to open new rooms and we are actively recruiting new teachers to do so
- Hiring is still a slow crawl across the industry, but we are making small strides every week
- We will open new rooms and offer spaces as we hire the staff; we do not have an exact timetable for this task
- We are also heavily focusing on staff retention to contribute to the center's long term success

 - Building the classroom teams with existing and new staff
 - o Regular check-ins with the staff to make sure their needs are being met

Health & Safety Updates

- Staff members who are not vaccinated and asymptomatic are testing every Sunday before the start of their work week
- We have gone digital with our daily staff health screenings. The staff members
 are able to fill out their health questionnaire ahead of time, similar to My Bright
 Day for families. This will speed up the temperature checks for staff and families
 now
- As we continue to battle this pandemic, we ask that staff and parents continue to answer the health screening questions truthfully and honestly
- We feel our Enhanced Protocols keep the center safe and healthy
