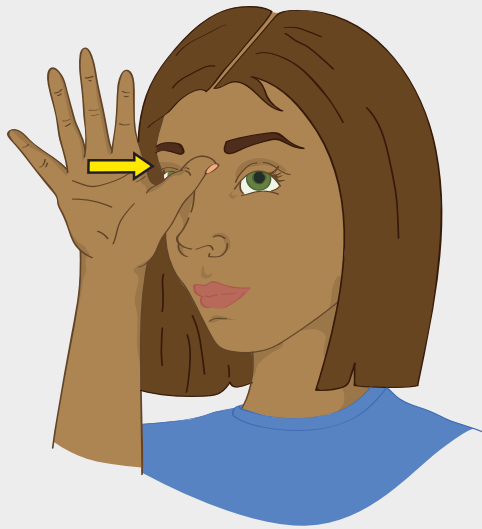
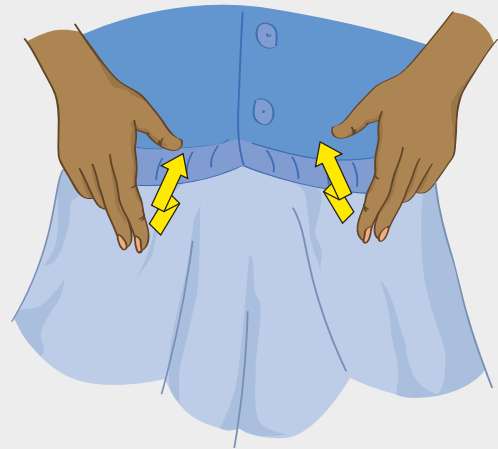


# Infant Sign Language

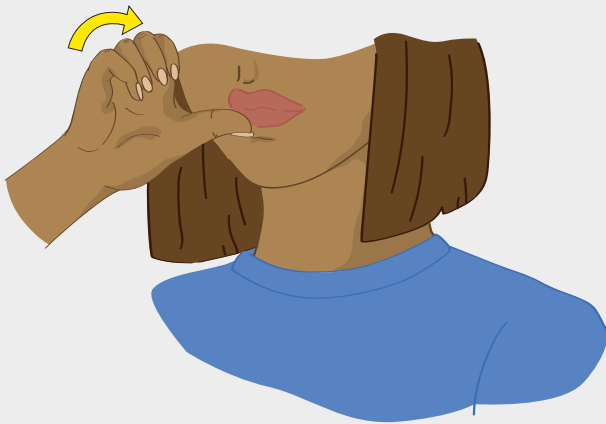
