Cloud Gazing



Learning Value:

Through this activity, your child will demonstrate use of creativity while also identifying shapes and observing nature.

Materials Needed:

Participants:

Directions:

- Step 1: On a clear day, lie on your back with your child and gaze at the sky. Toddlers will enjoy naming the clouds based on what they look like. You may need to start this activity by pointing out shapes in the clouds, e.g., "That cloud reminds me of a duck."
- Step 2: Children may become curious about why there are so many different shapes, why they change, or where they go when they disappear.
