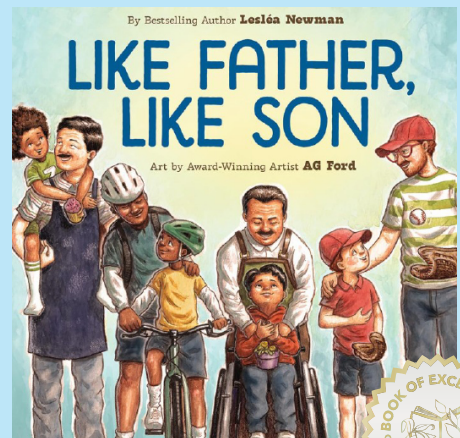
## Featured Book of Excellence

This picture book is a warm and engaging celebration of children noticing how they are like the people who love them most. Through everyday moments—biking, baking, gardening, sewing, and more—children can spot familiar habits, shared interests, and connections between themselves and their parents. The simple rhyming text invites young readers to say, “That sounds like me!”, while the expressive illustrations are full of movement, emotion, and recognizable family scenes. This book is a thoughtful choice to discuss relationships, hobbies, family bonds, and the ways children can be both just like someone — and uniquely themselves.

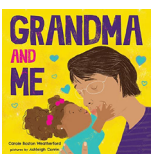
